

CONCLUSIONS

NASE courses, Georgia, 2025

The course of "Astronomy" attracted big interests amongst school teachers in Georgia. Application number was so high that the applicants were split in two groups. Only the applicants from different regions of Georgia were invited this time, while the teachers from Tbilisi will attend the same course in September.

Mostly teachers of physics attended the course. The participants were interested in both, lectures and practical presentations. There was very lively atmosphere and the teachers were asking many questions regarding how to explain some astronomical events to school students. The teachers were especially interested in observations and asked to conduct the course in observatory in order to make practical steps in managing telescopes.

Future connections between the professors of astronomy (who at the same time are professional astronomers) and school teachers were discussed after the course and some plans are adopted. The course made invaluable step into the promotion of astronomy across the civil society in Georgia.
